- 2 Character certificate from the Head of Institution, where the applicant has studied last, must be attached.
- 3 Caste certificate (if any) in prescribed format must be provided.
- 4 Reservation as per GoI rules will be applicable to applicants for M.Tech. (Applied Geology).

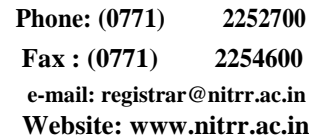
