General Instructions:

- Candidates eligible for appearing in Paper-I for any one or more posts of **Sr. No. 1,2 and 3** (i.e. Technical Assistant (Regular and Contract), Junior Engineer (Civil Engg. and Electrical Engg. and Pharmacist, respectively) need to appear in only one examination i.e. **Test Group-1** as per the above-mentioned schedule. If a candidate is eligible for more than one posts of Test Group-1, then he/she has to write Roll Numbers of all the posts mentioned in **Test Group-1** on Admit Card, Question Booklet and Answer Sheet of **Test Group-1**.
- Candidates eligible for appearing in Paper-I for any one or more posts of **Sr. No. 4 and 5** (i.e. Senior Technician and Technician (Regular and Contract), respectively) need to appear in only one examination i.e. **Test Group-2** as per the above-mentioned schedule. If a candidate is eligible for more than one posts of Test Group-2, then he/she has to write Roll Numbers of all the posts mentioned in **Test Group-2** on Admit Card, Question Booklet and Answer Sheet of **Test Group-2**.
- Candidates eligible for appearing in Paper-I for any one or more posts of **Sr. No. 6,7 and 8** (i.e. Senior Assistant, Junior Assistant (Regular & Contract) & Stenographer, respectively) need to appear in only one examination i.e. **Test Group-3** as per the above-mentioned schedule. If a candidate is eligible for more than one posts of Test Group-3, then he/she has to write Roll Numbers of all the posts mentioned in **Test Group-3** on Admit Card, Question Booklet and Answer Sheet of **Test Group-3**.
- Candidates eligible for appearing in Paper-1 for the post of **Sr. No. 9** (i.e. Office Attendant) need to appear in examination of **Test Group-4** as per the above-mentioned schedule.
- If a candidate has submitted multiple applications for the same post, then he/she may have been allotted Roll No. against each of the application in which he/she has been found provisionally eligible. However, during the Paper-1 examination for the posts, the candidate has to write all the allotted Roll Nos. on Answer Sheet.

Note:

- Candidate will not be allowed to enter in the Examination Hall after start of examination.
- Candidate will not be allowed to leave the examination hall after his/her entry till end of the examination.
- Candidature of those candidates found using any unfair means during examination will be rejected and will be barred from appearing in future examinations.
