## 38<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Board of Governors

## **Minutes**

The 38<sup>th</sup> meeting of Board of Governors of NIT Raipur was held on 16/10/2017 at the Conference Hall of NIT Transit House, New Delhi from 12:00 Hrs.

The Board members, Shri Kamal Sarda and Dr. Neelesh Jain, attended the meeting through video conferencing.

At the outset, Secretary, BoG informed that there exists a vacancy at the level of Chairperson, BoG as the same is yet to be appointed by the Hon'ble Visitor. Therefore, as per Statute No. 17(15) read with Section 16 of NITSER Act,-2012; the Director of the Institute can chair the meeting. Accordingly, Dr. A. M. Rawani, Director (I/c), NIT Raipur chaired the meeting of the BoG.

Ms. Sulochana Gadgil, did not attend the meeting. She was granted leave of absence.

The Chairman welcomed all the members and permitted the Secretary, BoG to present the agenda after ascertaining the quorum.

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## To confirm the minutes of 37th meeting of Board of Governors of NIT Raipur Agenda 38.1 held on 16.06.2017 at NIT Transit House, New Delhi.

The minutes of 37<sup>th</sup> meeting of BoG were circulated amongst the members and no comments were received thereon.

The minutes of 37th meeting of Board of Governors held on 16.06.2017 were Resolution confirmed since no comments were received.

- **Presentation of Director's Report** Agenda 38.3

The Director (I/C), NIT, Raipur presented the Director's report on the activities carried out in the Institute since the last BoG meeting on June 16, 2017. The JS(IFD) and FA suggested undertaking the Master's and Doctoral research on the problems being faced in the rural areas.

Resolution The Board noted the Director's report with the above direction.

Agenda 38.4 To note the minutes of 29th and 30th meeting of Senate held on 28.04.2017, 22.08.2017 at NIT Raipur.

> The Board advised to put only those agenda from Senate meeting which require specific approval of the Board as per the First Statutes of NITs and therefore there is no need tp place entire minutes before the Board for approval. It was brought to the notice of the Board that the Senate had recommended the amendment of Ph. D ordinance in 29th meeting held on 28-04-2017. It was advised that the amendment proposed by the Senate be put forth as separate agenda in the next BoG meeting for ratification.

Resolution Modification in Ordinance may be placed as a separate agenda item in next meeting of BoG.

Agenda 38.6 To consider the matter of compassionate appointment of dependents of Late Shri D.N. Diwakar and Late Shri D.K. Singh.

The Board was apprised that Shri Devnarayan Diwakar was Sr. Technical Assistant in Electronics Telecom. the Deptt. of & Engg. and had put in more than 22 years of service in the Institute and was retired from the service on 26.04.2016 on medical grounds at the age of 50 years with invalid pension. Shri Diwakar had applied on 15.12.2015 for compassionate appointment of his wife Mrs. Madhubala Diwakar on suitable post. Mrs. Diwakar is 1 mile

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Graduate in Science as well as Graduate in Library & Information Science. As per the records of the Institute, the retired employee has six dependent members including him and none of the dependent members are employed. To look into the matter of compassionate appointment, a committee was constituted vide No. NITRR/R-1/2016 dated 06.12.2016. The committee examined the case and found that the family had a financial liability and neither has any source of income nor a house or agricultural land. Further, as per the norms of the DoPT [vide DoPT. OM. No. 1401\*4/02/2012-Estt.(D) dated 16.01.2013), ), filled in Part A and Annexure A & B taken from the applicant and have been certified by the Head of the Office.

The Board was also apprised that the applicant Mrs. Diwakar is proposed to be appointed as office assistant in PB2 with GP 2000=00. There are 13 posts of office Assistant in the Institute out of which 12 are vacant. The appointment of Mrs. Diwakar will not exceed the ceiling of 5 % posts to be filled on compassionate grounds.

It was also apprised to the Board Shri D. K. Singh was Technical Assistant in the Deptt. of Civil Engg. and had put in more than 25 years of service in the Institute and expired on 09.06.2016 while in service at the age of 52 years. Mrs. Singh applied on 15.09.2017 for compassionate appointment of her son Mr. Divyansh Singh on suitable post whose educational qualification is Higher Secondary and is pursuing B.Tech Electronics & Telecom Engg. As per the records of the Institute, the deceased employee has three dependent members namely - his wife and two sons. To look into the matter of compassionate appointment, a committee was constituted vide No. NITRR/R-1/2016 dated 06.12.2016. As per the norms of the DoPT [vide DoPT. OM. No. 14014/02/2012- Estt. (D) dated 16.01.2013), filled in Part A and Annexure A & B were taken from the applicant. The committee constituted for considering the case of compassionate appointment went through the case and submitted its report on 07.06.2017. The designated committee cited that as per clarification at Point No. 11 (a) read with Para 18 contained in the DOPTs OM No. 14014/2/2/2012-Estt.(D) dated 16.01.2013, prior approval of the Secretary of the department/Ministry is required in order to consider this application.

It was also informed that Mrs. Sunita Singh w/o Shri D. K. Singh is a upper Division teacher (UDT) in a Government school and is drawing Rs. 59128 as emoluments in as the pension of Shri D. K. Singh. The liabilities as addition to Rs. 23749/mentioned by her are the Children's education and marriage.

The Board was apprised that all necessary instructions and guidelines of relevant DoPT circulars have been followed including that of ceiling of 5% of vacancy for compassionate appointment.

The Board sympathetically considered the two cases and found that only the case of Resolution Mrs. Diwakar has merit whereas the dependents of Mr. D. K. Singh have sufficient means to support themselves.

The Board approved only the appointment of Mrs. Madhubala Diwakar wife of late Shri D Diwakar on compassionate grounds in the post of Laboratory Assistant in PB2 with GP of 2000=00

Agenda 38.7 To consider and approve the External Expert members from Academia and Industry in the Departmental Academic Committee (DAC) Page 1 3 MAILA

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The lists of the names suggested by the various departments of the Institute were put before the Board. Each of the lists had five persons from academia and five from the Industry. The Board was informed that the panels for the annual academic review of the Departments would be constituted from the list. It was also informed to the Board that the existing approved list of the experts would expire in Nov. 2017.

Resolution The Board approved the list of experts from academia and the Industry for constitution of Departmental visiting committee and departmental academic committee.

Agenda 38.8 To consider and adopt the list of AMAs and Hospitals appointed and approved by Central Govt. Employees Welfare Coordination committee (CGEWCC) for treatment of employees of the Institute as well as their dependent family members & for reimbursement of their medical bills at CGHS, Delhi Rates.

> The Board was informed that The Chairman, Central Govt. Employees Welfare Coordination Committee, Raipur-C.G., in exercise of the powers under Rules 2(a)(A)(iv) of the Central Services (Medical Attendance) Rules, 1944, has appointed Medical Officers as the AMAs (Authorized Medical Attendants) for Central Govt. employees and their families posted in the state of Chhattisgarh for the year 2017-18 and the same along with the list of AMAs has been communicated by the Secretary, CGEWCC, Raipur vide his notification dated 12.05.2017. The JS (JFD) and FA suggested availing the services of the doctors from the

> approved list only upon the referral by the Institute Doctors except in case of emergency.

- The Board adopted he list of AMAs and centres/laboratories appointed and Resolution approved by CGEWCC for treatment of employees of the Institute as well as their dependent family members as mentioned on page 81-88 and centres /laboratories located in Bhilai/ Rajnandgaon on page no.92 of the detailed agenda as AMAs and for reimbursement of their medical bills at CGHS, Delhi Rates, only upon the referral by the Institute Doctors except in case of emergency. The City of Bhilai and Rajnandgaon are included as some of the employees of NIT live there.
