4. What is the admission process for all programs?

B.Tech./B.Arch:

The admission to 1st year of B.Tech./B.Arch Programme is made through the Joint Entrance Examination (Main) counselling conducted by JoSAA/CSAB and as per the guidelines framed by Ministry of Education, Govt. of India, Department of Higher Education.

M.Tech. :

The admission to 1st year of M.Tech (2 Yr) Programme is made by CCMT and M.Tech (Applied Geology) is 3 year Programme as per the guidelines framed by Ministry of Education, Govt. of India, Department of Higher Education.

The courses leading to M.Tech. are open to those who have obtained B.E./B.Tech. and for M.Tech. (Applied Geology) a degree in B.Sc. with Geology as an elective subject or B.E./B.Tech. in Mining Engineering is required with 60% marks or 6.5 CGPA in aggregate in the qualifying examination. However, the eligibility criteria may vary from time to time as per decision of the Senate. Relaxation up to 5% of marks or 0.5 CGPA can be allowed by Senate for sponsored Candidates with proven research or professional experience.

Regular Students:

Only GATE qualified candidates are admitted to M.Tech. Programmes. Seats are reserved for various categories i.e. ST/SC/OBC/EWS as per norms. When GATE qualified candidates are not available, admissions are given to those who are not qualified in GATE on the basis of merit as detailed in P.G. regulation.

Sponsored Students:

- i) Few seats are also available for sponsored candidates. Sponsored candidates are not eligible to receive scholarship even if they are GATE qualified.
- ii) The candidates must have a total of minimum two years full time work experience in the sponsored organization which should be a reputed one.
- iii) There is no age restriction. However, preference is given to those who are below 45 years of age.
- iv) Sponsorship certificate in proper proforma is required from the employer at the time of admission.

M.C.A.:

The admission to 1st year of MCA (3 Year) Programme is made through the NIT MCA Common Entrance Test, counselling conducted by NIMCET and as per the guidelines framed by Ministry of Education, Government of India.

M.Sc.:

The minimum qualification for admission to the first semester of M. Sc. Course shall normally be the passing of a Bachelor of Science with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics as a subject having 60% for General; OBC(NCL), EWS and 55% for SC, ST and Physically Challenged persons, conducted by recognized Institute/University as per the instructions received from Ministry of Education, Govt. of India from time to time.

Admission of Indian Nationals to the first semester of M.Sc. Course shall be through his relative performance in Joint Admission test for Masters (JAM) leading to securing a place in merit list of eligible candidates and as governed by the rules of Central Counseling for M.Sc. for NIT's (CCMN) time to time.

Ph.D. Courses:

The Institute Provides facilities for research including that for the degree of Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) in Engineering, Science, Humanities and Social Sciences.

Students:

National Institute of Technology Raipur has always been the preferred destination of the bright students. Students of N.I.T. Raipur are also known for their excellence in socio-cultural activities and sports. This multilingual and multicultural environment is particularly conducive to its future development. 5. What types of scholarships does NIT Raipur provide to its students?

1.	Dr. K. K. Sugandhi Scholarship	2011	Prof. K. K. Sugandhi, the Ex-Director of NIT Raipur has constituted this scholarship. One scholarship of the value Rs. 1100/- per month for ten monthly installments, awarded to the student securing the highest CPI (Cumulative Performance Indicator) and having an annual family income less than Rs.2.5 Lacs, studying in B.Tech. 2nd year.
2.	Full Tuition Fee Reimbursement for economically backward students	2020	This scholarship, established by the institute, is awarded to a select number of B.Tech./B.Arch. students whose annual parental income falls between Rs. 1-5 Lacs. The scholarship provides a one-time grant covering the full tuition fee. Selection is based on the merit (CPI) achieved by the student in the previous year.
3.	Sh. Manghandas & Smt. Sundari Devi Hablani Memorial Scholarship	2022	Mr. Hari Hablani, an alumnus of NIT Raipur has constituted this award in loving memory of his parents. Forty scholarships (ten from each year of B.Tech.) of the value Rs. 15,600/- (for 1st year) and Rs. 9,000/- (for 2nd, 3rd & 4th years) one-time grant for each shortlisted student whose family's annual income is less than 1 Lac.
4.	Shraman Foundation Scholarship	2022	NIT Raipur has partnered with the Shraman Foundation, a non-profit organization, to offer scholarships to financially disadvantaged undergraduate students. Selected students receive a one-time grant ranging from Rs. 15,000 to Rs. 20,000, determined by the Shraman Foundation's selection process.

5.	Dr. M L Kathuriya & Smt. Pramila Devi Kathuriya Memorial Scholarship	2023	The Merit-Cum-Means Scholarship is established by the daughters and families of Dr. M. L. Kathuriya and Smt. Pramila Devi Kathuriya, aids two deserving female B.Tech. 2nd-year (Mechanical Engg.) students seeking financial assistance and having an annual family income of under 5 Lacs. Each shortlisted recipient is awarded a one-time grant of Rs. 25,000 to support their education.

6. Whether any Scholarship is given to SC/ST students of NIT Raipur?

SC/ST students are eligible for Post Matric Scholarship (PMS) of the respective State Governments if they satisfy the norms set by the State Govt. For that they need to apply in appropriate time to their State Govts.

Among the admitted students in the first year top 12 SC students and top 5 ST students are eligible to get TOP CLASS SCHOLARSHIP from the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, GOI and the Ministry of Tribal Affairs, GOI respectively provided their parental annual income is below 4.5 lakhs. These students will get Top Class scholarship for four years (first year to fourth year) provided they get promoted to the next higher year, else the scholarship will be stopped.

7. What are the different schemes under which a foreign student can take admission?

At NIT Raipur a foreign student can take admission under DASA, ICCR and MEA schemes.

9. What kind of sports and fitness facilities are available at the Institute?

The Institute provides ample avenues for the development and nurturing of creative and other talents in the students through Sports Department. It has facilities for OPD treatment and works as a primary care center with all necessary facilities and scope for a referral to higher centers as and when required. The medical facilities are completely free for the Institute students. 24x7 Ambulance service is also available to provide emergency services to anyone.

13. What are the key features and resources available at the Central Library of NIT Raipur, and how does it support its users?

The Central Library of NIT, Raipur has a good collection of more than 1 lakh of print books , more than 1.7 lacs e-books consisting of both text and reference books Ph.D theses, online journal Archive collections and online protocols . Besides it subscribes to a good number of full text online databases ,Indian print journals . The Central Library is fully automated through LibSys7- Library management software .The Web OPAC is fully functional. RFID system has been installed in the Reading Room of Central Library.It also has Discovery Service ,Remote access facilities and plagiarism check software like Turnitin Feedback Studio and URKUND .It caters to the information and document need of nearly 5000 users consisting of Faculty members, staff, B.Tech/M.Tech/MCA students and research scholars satisfactorily.
