| Resolution | In wake of the COVID-19 pandemic, until the institute is able to conduct offline examinations, the Senate approved to follow the continuous assessment modalities for the theory and practical subjects across all programmes as has been duly approved in the 41 st meeting of Senate held on 25.09.2020 but with the following modifications in the mode of conducting MCQ examinations: - A. For CBCS scheme of studies, three MCQ examinations each of 10 marks may be conducted in lieu of the prevailing two MCQs of 15 marks each. The marks are to be entered in cumulative out of 30 marks in MIS for mid semester examinations. B. For NIT scheme of studies, existing MCQs of 15 marks may now be divided into two/three MCQ examinations (of 10+5/5+5+5 markings respectively) by the different departments with approval of the respective HoD. This will be for FE which comprises of two units of Syllabus. The SE can be taken in the same manner from the other two units. The marks out of 15 for each of FE and SE are to be entered in MIS. It has been also resolved that the number of MCQs and their marks distribution, as above, must be duly approved by DAC/HoD and should be informed to the students in advance. |
