He did his B.E. in Civil Engineering from (Osmania), M.Tech from (IIT Delhi), Ph.D. and Post Doctorate from U.K. in Civil and Structural Engineering from University of Wales, Swansea, United Kingdom.

He has held several Administrative posts as Registrar, JNTU, Kukatpally, Hyderabad from 30th Apr. 2012 to 21st Jul. 2015, as Principal, JNTUH College of Engineering Hyderabad, Kukatpally, Hyderabad from 30th Apr. 2008 to 24th Nov. 2011, as Director, Bureau of Industrial Consultancy Services, JNT University, Hyderabad from 5th Sep. 2003 to 5th May 2006, as Co-ordinator, Entrepreneurship Development Cell, JNT *University*, *Hyderabad* from 1st Aug. 2002 to 31st Jan. 2004. He has also served as the **Director** (Additional charge), NIT Andhra Pradesh from 23rd Oct. 2017 to 23rd Mar. 2018 and **Director** (Additional charge), SPA, Vijayawada from 18th Nov. 2021 to 23rd Sep. 2022. **Dr. Ramana Rao** has edited three books and published 186 papers in International Journals/International Conferences/ National Journals/ National Conferences. He has organized 12 Conferences/Workshops, Delivered 15 invited lectures. He has guided more than 80 M.Techs., 13 Ph.Ds. and guiding at present several Ph.Ds. Institute News

Organized the 13th Convocation Ceremony



NIT Raipur organised its 13th Convocation Ceremony on 13th May 2023 at Pandit Deendayal Upadhyay Auditorium, Raipur. Dr. Shailendra V. Gade, Scientist & Director General (ACE), DRDO, Alumnus, NIT Raipur was the Chief Guest of the event. Dr. (Mrs.) A. B. Soni, Director (I/C) & Acting Chairman, Board of Governors, NIT Raipur presided over the ceremony in the presence of all the Deans, HoDs, and faculty members and staffs. The ceremony commenced with the welcoming of the Director, Deans and HoDs by a formal procession led by Dr. P. Y. Dhekne, Registrar, NIT Raipur followed by the National Song. Dr. (Mrs.) A. B. Soni initiated the ceremony by delivering the annual institute report, the presidential address, elucidating the numerous accomplishments and the long-term future plans of the Institute. Yeleti Sri Satyalakshmi, B. Tech., IT bagged the Institute Gold medal for being the Overall **Topper** for the year 2022.

Mr. Amulya Priyadarshi, Acting Chief General Manager, Human Resources Development (HRD), BSP, Mr. Mukhul Saharia, Deputy General Manager, HRD, BSP were present to welcome the delegates. Mr. A. Priyadarshi highlighted BSP's significance as a flagship company of the Steel Authority of India (S.A.I.L) and its premier status as Maharatna. 
